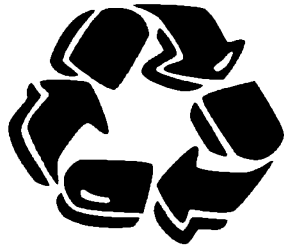

Recycle with Us

As consumers you can help out by buying supplies made with recycled content. Over 3,500 products are currently available with recycled content. Look at the PCC% on your paper products such as envelopes, copier paper, tablets and more. This number indicates the amount of post consumer content used when making the product, the higher the number the greater amount of recycled content.

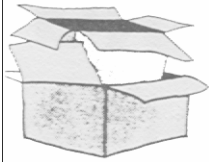

What to Recycle



Cardboard— Corrugated boxes and kraft paper bags. **NO** gift, cereal or tissue boxes



White high grade office paper — computer paper, copy paper, etc. **NO** windowed envelopes, ream wrappers, or carbon paper



Clear, Brown & Green Glass Bottles — separate by color and remove lids. **NO** window pane, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics



Steel (food cans) and Aluminum (beverage cans) **NO** foil pie tins, aerosol cans or paint cans



Newspaper — must be dry. Inserts and advertisements are allowed.

How to Prepare Recyclables

1. All bottles, jars and cans must be emptied and rinsed.
2. Remove all bottle caps and lids.
3. Flatten cardboard
4. Separate materials. (i.e. clear glass from green, steel cans from aluminum)
5. Arrange to have recyclables delivered to a recycling facility.

A quarterly Recycling Report will be necessary for properties that do not have their recyclables delivered to Bloomsburg's Recycling Center. Weigh slips for all materials recycled during the quarter must accompany the report.

OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED AT

BLOOMSBURG'S RECYCLING CENTER

Plastic bottles #1 and #2 — Soda bottles, milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, etc.
Magazines and catalogs
Hardcover and paperback books

Recycle It's the Law

PA Act 101 requires businesses in any municipality with more than 5,000 residents to recycle.

Under 500 lbs \$50

501-1000 lbs \$75

1001—2000 lbs \$150

over 2000 lbs Base fee \$150 + corresponding weight shown above
