

The Special Meeting of the Bloomsburg Municipal Authority Board was held Thursday, July 31, 2014, 4:30pm in Council Chambers of Town Hall, Bloomsburg, PA.

Thomas Evans presided. Those present included: Board Members Lawrence Mack, Claude Renninger and Carey Howell; Plant Superintendent Daniel Murphy and Assistant Secretary Carol Mas. Absent was Board Member Andrew Keister.

APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE TEMPORARY LIQUID SLUDGE HAULING

On a motion by C. Howell, seconded by C. Renninger and voted on unanimously, the Board approved advertising for temporary sludge hauling.

APPROVAL OF SITE VISIT BY ALLIANTGROUP REPRESENTATIVES

On a motion by C. Renninger, seconded by L. Mack and voted on unanimously, the Board approved a site visit by Alliantgroup representatives on behalf of George J. Hayden, Inc. to qualify a 179D tax credit for utilizing energy efficient designs in the renovation project.

APPROVAL OF CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND VISITOR'S BUREAU MERGE

On a motion by C. Renninger, seconded by L. Mack and voted on unanimously, the Board approved a "Yes" vote to the Columbia Montour Chamber of Commerce and the Columbia County Visitor's Bureau merging.

STATUS OF DELINQUENCIES

The Board questioned the status of the water shut-offs due to non-payment of delinquent sewer charges and asked when the solicitor filed with the courts the legality of requiring a list of tenants. A report will be expected at the August meeting.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned into a work session at 4:43pm.
