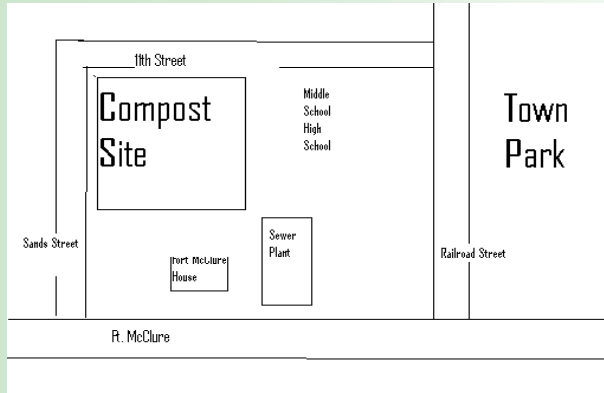


# COMPOST SITE

## COMPOST SITE HOURS

**Wednesday's**

**4:00 p.m. — 7:00 p.m.**

**Saturday's**

**8:00 a.m. — 2:00 p.m.**

Note Wednesday's hours change in mid  
October to 2:00 p.m.—5:00 p.m.

Residents may pick up mulch or compost (while  
available) at no charge. Loading is the respon-  
sibility of the resident. A \$10 fee applies to  
all non residents. Pick up a voucher at the  
Recycling Center prior to going to the Compost  
Site

Drop-off items include leaves, brush and  
branches up to 6' in length and 4" in diameter.  
Also grass and garden residues. Non residents  
must purchase a voucher to drop off yard  
waste.

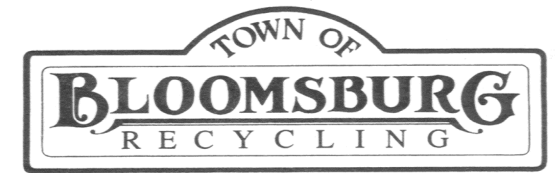
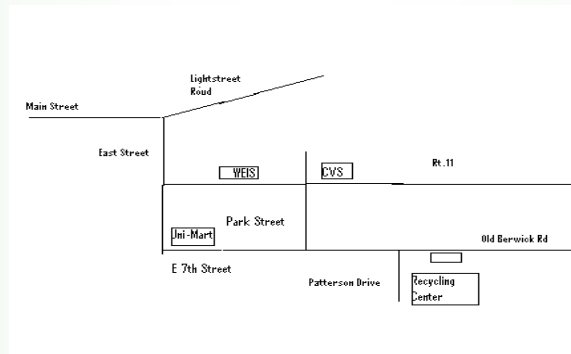

# BLOOMSBURG RECYCLING CENTER DROP OFF GUIDE

## PAPER

Recycling one ton of paper saves 17 trees, and 7000 gallons of water.

BINS ARE LABELED FOR THE SEPARATION OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:



NEWSPAPER

Includes all inserts.



CARDBOARD

Corrugated boxes and paper bags



MAGAZINES

Includes all glossy catalogs and brochures



HARDCOVER BOOKS

Includes encyclopedias and other bound books



OFFICE PAPER

Shredded or whole, lined or unlined paper



MIXED PAPER

Includes junk mail, envelopes, paste board boxes, phone books and paper-back books.

## PLASTIC

The Bloomsburg Recycling Center is expanding plastic recycling and asking YOU to place #1 plastics in one bin, #2 in a separate bin and #3 - #7 in a third bin.



PET, PETE  
Polyethylene Terephthalate

Water Bottles • Soda Drinks • Sports Drinks  
Peanut Butter Containers • Salad Dressing  
Condiments • Vegetable Oil Containers



HDPE  
High-Density Polyethylene

Milk Jugs • Water Jugs • Juice Jugs  
Bleach Jugs • Household Cleaners  
Laundry Detergents • Dish Detergents



LDPE  
Low Density Polyethylene

Fresh Produce Container Lids •  
Reusable Food & Drink Containers  
Some Baby Bottles  
Squeezable Bottles (e.g. Honey & Mustard)



PVC  
Polyvinyl Chloride

Some Detergent & Spray  
Bottles



PP  
Polypropylene

Burger & Yogurt Tubs  
Deli Take-Out Containers  
Medicine Bottles • Bottle Caps  
Reusable Food & Drink Containers



PS  
Polystyrene

Aspirin & Vitamin bottles  
Yogurt tubs & lids

Plastic grocery bags are not accepted at this time.

## GLASS



ACCEPTABLE— Glass bottles and jars  
NOT ACCEPTABLE— window pane, ceramics, light bulbs.  
SEPARATE BY COLOR  
CLEAR | BROWN | GREEN

## METALS



SEPARATE BY METAL  
STEEL CANS— all food cans, labels may remain on the cans.  
ALUMINUM CANS — beverage cans and some food cans

## OTHER

WASTE OIL — includes both vegetable and motor oil
