Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, March 21, 2023, 10:00 a.m.

Chairperson Justin Hummel called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., present were Council members Bonnie Crawford, James Garman, and Vince DeMelfi, Town Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Lisa Dooley, Chief of Police Scott Price, Code Enforcement Officer Kyle Bauman, Administrative Assistant Randi Fetterman (10:30 a.m.), Administrative Assistant Elise Hughes and Tracy Kishbaugh. Also in attendance were Council member Jim Huber and MJ Mahon.

On a motion by B. Crawford, seconded by J. Garman, and voted on unanimously, the Committee approved the 2/21/2023 meeting minutes with one error, correcting Fire Chief Scott McBride's name.

Discussion took place regarding the need to replace Visual Alert due to the program's end of life. E. Hughes discussed parking software options. J. Hummel agrees there needs to be software changes and pricing needs to be compared. Council does not want to raise downtown parking prices. Passport is the software that seems most promising. J. Hummel would like to see a system that is more user friendly to everyone, staff and consumers alike.

Discussion took place regarding the reconfiguring of the Pine Avenue lots. Suggested for Zone D (East Pine Avenue) is that the lot would consist of all PANGO and permit spaces, no meters. Zone E (Pine Avenue) would see PANGO spaces and meters lined on the Northern row closes to Main Street, and Zone I (West Pine Avenue) would convert to all permit spaces, with the exception of 7 metered/PANGO spaces nearest to Main Street.

On a motion by J. Hummel, seconded by J. Garman, and voted on unanimously, the Committee approved the three-lot reconstruction be taken to Town Council for approval.

On a motion by B. Crawford, seconded by J. Garman, and voted on unanimously, the Committee voted to adjourn the meeting at 11:21 a.m.
