Compost Site Hours


Wednesday's: 4pm-7pm MARCH – SEPTEMBER

Compost Site

Located at the corner of
Sands & 11th St. access off of
Ft. McClure Blvd



Residents may pick up mulch or compost (while available) at no charge. Loading is the responsibility of the resident. A \$10 fee applies to all non-residents. Pick up a voucher at the Recycling Center prior to going to the Compost Site.

Drop-off items include leaves, brush and branches up to 6' in length and 4" in diameter. No grass clippings. Nonresidents must purchase a voucher to drop off yard waste.

Recycling Center Drop Off Guide

PAPER

Bins are labeled for the separation of the following items:



NEWSPAPER

Includes all inserts



CARDBOARD

Corrugated boxes and paper bags



MIXED PAPER

Includes junk mail, envelopes, paste board boxes, phone books, paperback books, & magazines



HARDCOVER BOOKS

Includes encyclopedias & other bound books



OFFICE PAPER

Shredded or whole, lined or unlined paper

PLASTIC

Plastics should be sorted into the following four

PET & PETE:

Water Bottles, Soft Drinks, Sports Drinks, Peanut Butter Containers, Salad Dressing Condiments, Vegetable Oil Containers

HDPE:

Natural- Milk Jugs, Water Jugs, Juice Jugs

HDPE:

Colors- Bleach Jugs, Household Cleaners, Laundry Detergents, Dish

OTHER:

#3: Spray Bottles

#4: Fresh Produce Container Lids, Reusable

Food and Drink Containers, Some Baby Bottles, Squeezable Bottles (e.g. Honey & Mustard)

#5: Butter Tubs, Medicine Bottles, Bottle Caps

#6: Aspirin & Vitamin Bottles, Yogurt Tubs & Lids

#7: Any other plastic containers (NO STYROFOAM OR PLASTIC BAGS)

GLASS



ACCEPTABLE

- Glass Bottles
- Jars

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Windowpane
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs

Separate by Color:

CLEAR | BROWN | GREEN

METALS



Separate by Metal:

Steel Cans

All food cans, labels may remain on the cans

Aluminum Cans

Beverage cans, cat food cans, and some food cans

OTHER

Scrap Metal

Pots, pans, metal parts, microwaves

NO ELECTRONICS
OR FREON ITEMS

Plastic Film

Grocery bags, packaging air packs, bread bags, Ziploc bags, water case overwrap, empty trash bags
