

# Curbside Guidelines

## TOWN OF Bloomsburg RECYCLING

### Center Hours

If you are away during regularly scheduled curbside collection or need to drop off recycling, the Recycling Center Drop Off Hours are:

Monday, Tuesday & Thursday:	7am-5pm
Wednesday:	CLOSED
Friday:	7am-3pm
2 <sup>nd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> Saturday:	9am-1pm

The Recycling Center is Closed on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- President's Day
- Good Friday
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving
- Thursday-Monday
- Christmas

NOTE: Curbside collection days that fall on a holiday will be made up later in the week. Check calendar for details. If you need a calendar, contact the Recycling Center Office.

### Instructions

The following items will be collected. All the materials listed to the right must be separated in a box or bin when placed at the curb. Have materials at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on the day of collection. NO PLASTIC BAGS.



**CLEAR GLASS:** All bottles and jars must be emptied and rinsed, and all caps & lids removed. NO windowpanes, light bulbs, mirrors, or ceramics. KEEP SEPARATE FROM COLLORED GLASS



**COLORLED GLASS:** Includes brown, green, & blue. Bottles & jars must be emptied, with caps and lids removed. KEEP SEPARATE FROM CLEAR GLASS.



**METAL CANS:** Includes both steel and aluminum cans in one bin. All cans must be emptied and rinsed. NO foil, pans, or aerosol cans.



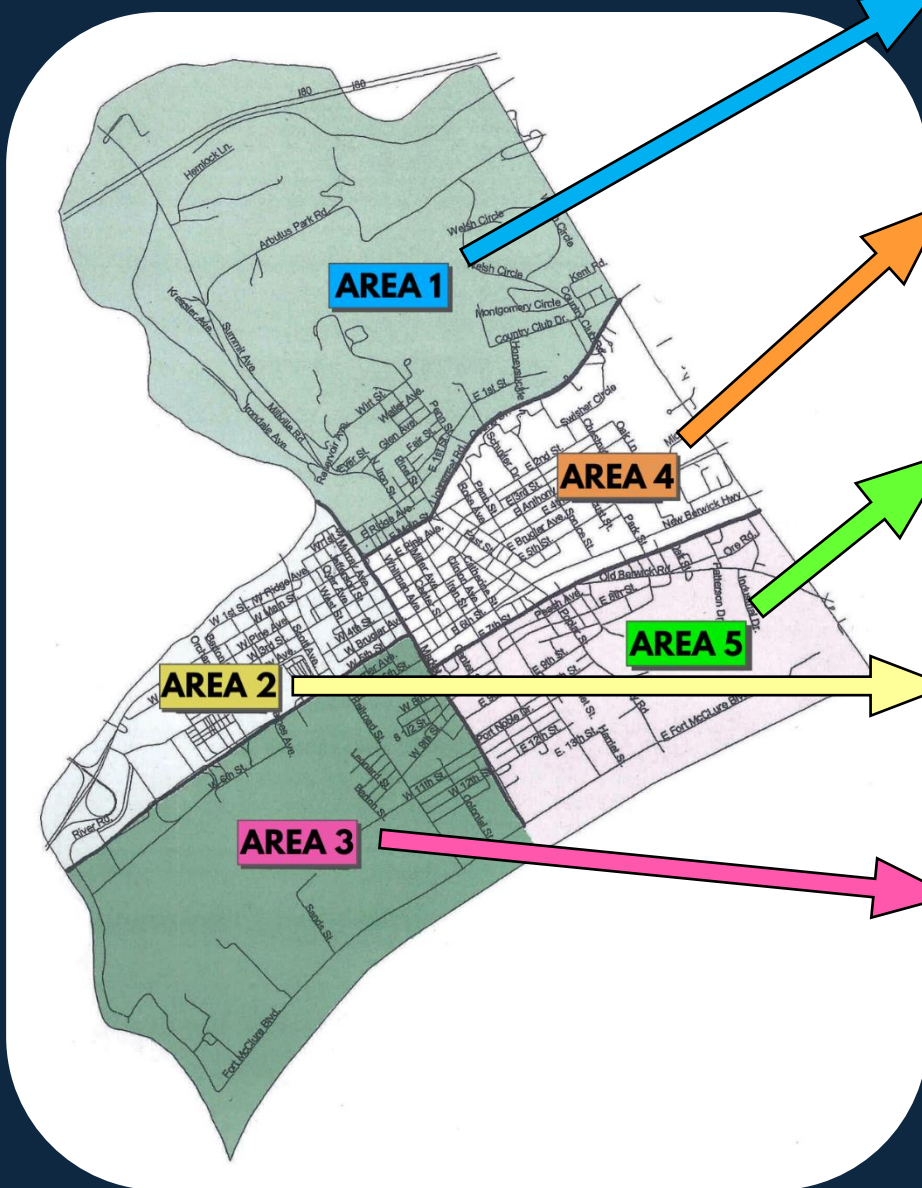
**PLASTIC:** #1 and #2 plastic bottles (soda, milk, detergent bottles). Empty and rinse, discard caps and lids, flatten. NO plastic bags, ice cream buckets, yogurt cups, motor oil bottles, or butter tubs.



**NEWSPRINT:** newspapers, bundle or bag (paper bags only). NO magazines, junk mail or phone books.



**MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, JUNK MAIL, & PASTEBOARD BOXES:** includes cereal, tissue, pasta, and shoeboxes. Also includes phone books. KEEP SEPARATE FROM NEWSPAPER, DOES NOT INCLUDE CARDBOARD



## AREA 1

Collection includes both sides of Lightstreet Road. Both sides of Main Street to the Fountain Square. Includes the east side north of the Fountain.

## AREA 4

South of Lightstreet Road, includes all rear Main Street to Market St. Ends north of 7<sup>th</sup> Street. DOES NOT include any of 7<sup>th</sup> Street. East of Market St. DOES NOT include any of Market St.

## AREA 5

All area south of 7<sup>th</sup> Street, includes both sides of 7<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Market St. DOES NOT include any of Market St.

## AREA 2

Both sides of Market St. from Main Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Includes the west side north of the fountain. Collection includes all streets and alleys up to but DOES NOT include 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

## AREA 3

Both sides of 5<sup>th</sup> Street west of Market St. Includes both sides of Market St. from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Ft. McClure Blvd.

## Collections

Collections are every other week on the following days:

AREA 1: Monday

AREA 2: Tuesday

AREA 3: Wednesday

AREA 4: Monday

AREA 5: Tuesday

## Cardboard Collection

### Schedule

- Monthly collections
- AREAS 1-2-3: first Thursday
- AREAS 4-5: second Thursday

Recycling is **MANDATORY** in Bloomsburg for all residents, businesses, schools, offices, and multi-family housing properties. The Town provides **ALL** residential curbside collection per ordinance #862.

## Curbside Collection

### for Leaf and Yard Waste

- JANUARY- Christmas trees are collected at the curb every Monday.
- APRIL- Leaf and yard waste spring collection, check calendar for details.
- OCTOBER- first week is fall brush and yard waste collection. Leaf collection begins in the third week of October until Thanksgiving.
- NOTE- Yard waste collection follows the street sweeper schedule posted on each street.
