The landlord or agent is responsible for setting up a convenient location for the collection and storage of all recyclables.

Clearly marketed recycling containers must be set out for tenants' recyclables. The landlord or agent is to make arrangements for the materials to be delivered to a recycling facility. A code enforcement officer will verify that a recycling system exists during annual inspections.

<u>Methods of Removal of</u> <u>Recyclables:</u>

Landlord or agent may deliver the recyclables directly to a Recycling Center.

Landlord may contract with a private hauler for the removal of recyclables or owners may elect to have recyclable materials collected curbside by the Town. Should this method be chosen, the owner would be subject to the same recycling fee for each dwelling unit as those eligible for curbside recycling.

Recycling Guidelines for Multi-Family Housing Properties

Bloomsburg Ordinance #862 Requires ALL Residents to Recycle the Following Items:

PLASTIC BOTTLES



Plastic Bottles- #1 PET & #2 HDPE, includes water, soda, milk, and laundry bottles

GLASS BOTTLES



Glass bottles- includes all clear, brown, and green glass bottles

METAL CANS



Metal Cans- includes both steel and aluminum cans, emptied and rinsed

MIXED PAPER



Mixed Paper- includes junk mail, window envelopes, paste board boxes, paperback books, newspaper, and magazines

Town Toter Collection Program

- One recycling area for the entire building

Multi-Family properties are those which have more than four (4) units

The landlord or agent of each property shall require tenants to recycle by a clause in the lease or other enforceable rule or regulation to abide by the requirements set forth in Ordinance #862.
