## Accepted:

- Junk Mail and Envelopes (with or without windows)
- File folders
- Manila Envelopes
- Posters
- Greeting Cards
- Paperboard Boxes and Cartons (cereal, shoe box, gift box, rice, pasta, frozen food, cookie/ cracker boxes, etc.)
- Paper Towel Tubes
- Phone Books
- Writing Tablets
- Flyers/Brochures

## Not Accepted:

milk cartons, juice boxes  
photographs, carbon paper, plates,  
cups, utensils or any non-paper  
item such as styrofoam, plastic or  
metals



## NOW ACCEPTS MIXED PAPER

### What is mixed paper?

Mixed paper is just that, it includes cereal boxes, telephone books, unwanted mail, and so on. You don't need to remove metal staples or plastic windows on envelopes.

Some items that are **NOT** accepted include waxed paper, paper towels, tissues, foil wrap and paper beverage containers such as milk or juice cartons.
